























Turning the Calculator on and off

About the Buttons

A majority of the buttons on the Ti-84 graphing calculator have 3 functions. The first function of the button is labeled on the button itself. The second function to each button is listed above the button to the left and is color-coded blue with the  button on the calculator. The third function to each button is listed above the button to the right and is color-coded green with the  button. These buttons will be discussed in more detail in a future section.
